Mary Bellman is a clinical professor in the School of Labor and Employment Relations at Penn State University. In that role, she serves as director of the department's outreach program to the Pennsylvania labor movement, known as The Labor School, and she teaches a wide range of courses for union members, staff, and leadership. With over two decades of experience as a labor educator, Dr. Bellman has developed and facilitated numerous labor leadership programs in Pennsylvania, Minnesota and nationally. From 2018 to 2022, she served two terms as national president of the United Association for Labor Education (UALE), the professional organization for labor education in higher education, unions, and community organizations in the United States. Dr. Bellman holds a Ph.D. in political science from the University of New Mexico. Before joining the faculty at Penn State, she served as program director for a labor solidarity organization in Central America and worked at the Labor Education Service in her home state of Minnesota.
