Crosatto is the directing business representative for Machinists Automotive Trades District 190 of Northern California, where he is responsible for negotiating and servicing contracts in the automotive and trucking industries, shipping lines, sanitation, commercial bakeries and other industries. Prior to his current position, he was the organizing director of District 190. Crosatto was also the founding editor of The Sparkplug, an award-winning labor newspaper. He serves as a trustee of the Automotive Industries Welfare Fund, the Automotive Industries Pension Fund, the CMTA-IAM Joint Retiree Health and Welfare Fund, and the Michael J. Day Machinists Retiree Health Investment Trust. Crosatto also chairs the California Machinists 401(k) Trust and Automotive Industry Apprenticeship Trust Fund. He currently serves as Past President and Chair of the International Foundation Board of Directors and its Executive Committee. Crosatto is a member of the Strategic Initiative Steering Committee, serves as the Executive Liaison for the Government Liaison Committee, and was previously the Executive Liaison for the Financial Review Committee and Chair of the Trustee Committee. Crosatto is a former member of the Alameda County Central Labor Council Executive Committee, where he was named the 2008 Unionist of the Year.
