

Gabrielle Slowey, Ph.D. Associate Professor, Department of Politics

Dr. Gabrielle Slowey is an associate professor in the Department of Politics at York University where she teaches courses in Canadian, Indigenous and Arctic Politics. Her research investigates the intersection between governance, resource extraction, economic development, labour, the environment and the state in multiple northern/Arctic regions (Northern Alberta, Northern Québec, Yukon, NWT, Ontario, the United States, Australia and New Zealand). Dr. Slowey is the author of *Navigating Neoliberalism: Self-Determination and the Mikisew Cree First Nation* (UBC Press, 2008). She earned a Ph.D. degree in political science and government from the University of Alberta, a master's degree in political science and government from the University of New Brunswick, and a bachelor's degree in French language, literature and political science from the University of Toronto—Trinity College.
